


Notable Events

December 19th, 1843

Charles Dickens' classic work, A Christmas Carol, was published.


Dickens produced this iconic work in a six-week flurry of writing that began in October 1843 and finished on 19th December. By December 24th, the first edition of 6,000 copies had sold out and by 2nd January 1844, a second edition of 3,000 copies had been sold.





December 17th, 1903

December 17, 1903 was a day that would launch the world into the future all thanks to two brothers. Orville and Wilbur Wright, known as the Wright Brothers, took the first ever successful flight in a man-powered airplane.



December 21st, 1968

Apollo 8, the first manned mission to the moon, was successfully launched from Cape Canaveral, Florida, with astronauts James Lovell, Frank Borman, and William Anders on board.

A few days later, on Christmas Eve, the crew entered into orbit around the moon – making history as the first ever manned spacecraft to do so. During Apollo 8's 10 orbits around the moon, incredible images were taken of the moon and of Earth from the spacecraft and sent back home

Apollo 8 landed safely in the Pacific Ocean on 27th December

Also, perhaps from the 2nd auto accident that destroyed her beautiful Mustang, but again, she survived. The last time I saw them both was the day some months ago now, when I visited them in hospital the day she was being released. That involved the photo I sent out with her wearing that black "Pirate" eye patch over her right eye. That has passed and is no longer needed.

I contacted her today to wish them a Merry Christmas and she responded with the following info. Her home, like many of ours, is full of their Daughters and dogs as they celebrate Christmas. She is doing better, but has not been released to drive yet, however, she says she can. She will be seeing her Neurologist soon to see if they are ready to release her for driving and also wean her off some of the meds she is required to take now. She will also be seeing a Spinal doctor to see what can be done to improve that area. Then she will start looking for another 2005 Retrobird (50th Anniversary edition I assume), either Red or Black! She said there is nothing wrong with her accelerator foot! (Smile!). Here is a recent photo of what she looks like now since they got all the life saving tubes, and attachments off her before she left the hospital. They miss the friendship of the Club Membership and wish ya'll a Merry Christmas and a very Happy New Year.





